Bristol Temple Meads (BRI) is a 25 minute walk via Portwall Lane and Queen of Nails Square. A taxi rank is on the station forecourt. Depending on traffic conditions, the journey can take between 12 and 20 minutes.



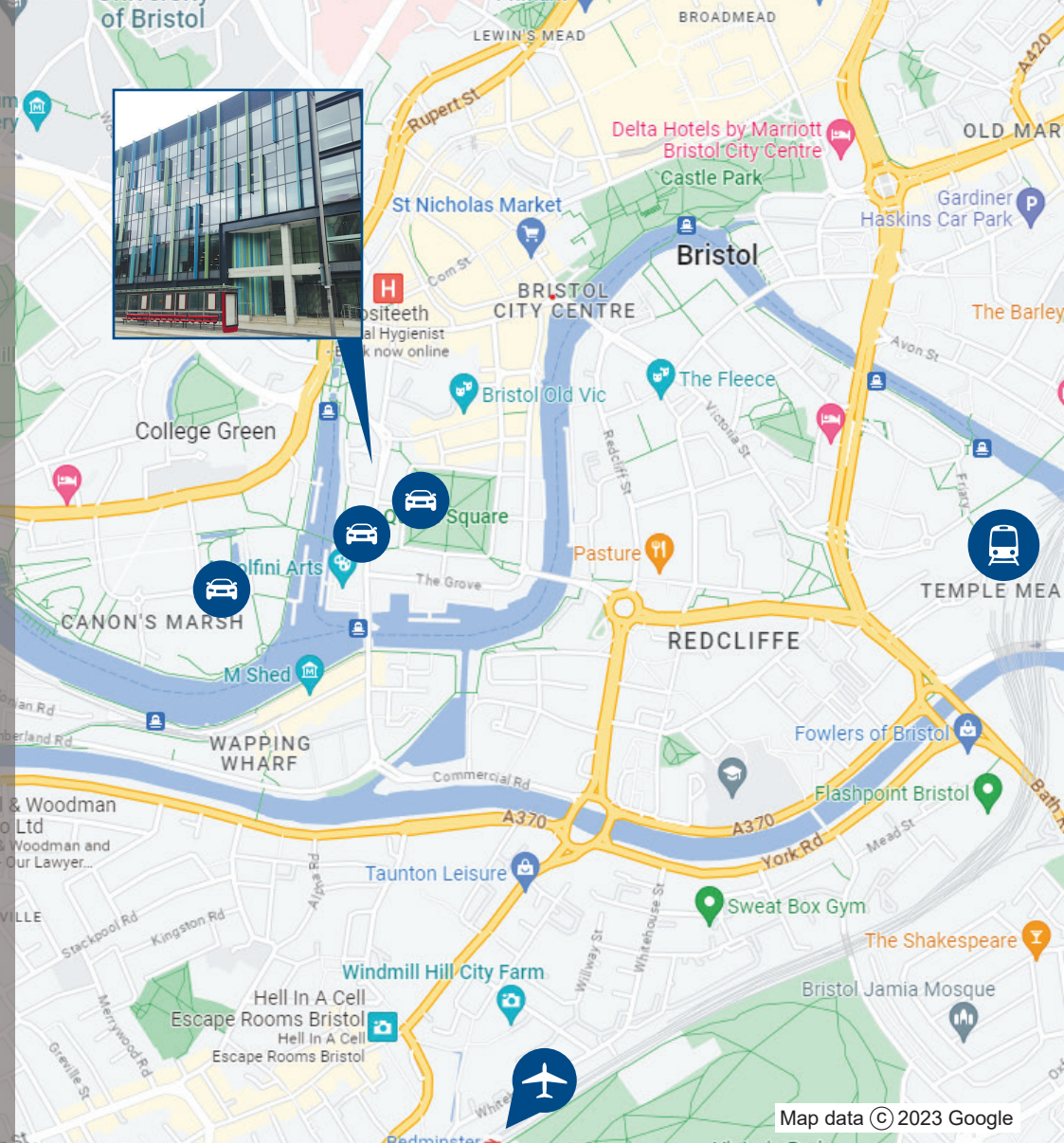
The nearest airport for international and domestic flights is Bristol Airport (BRS). A bus route, known as The Airport Flyer, connects the airport to Bristol Temple Meads and the local bus network. Buses run 24 hours a day, seven days a week. At peak times, they leave up to every eight minutes outside the terminal building, the journey to Temple Meads takes around 30 minutes. Alternatively, a taxi rank is located outside the terminal building, a taxi journey to Narrow Quay House can take between 18 and 40 minutes.



If on arrival to the office you find that the ground floor reception is not staffed, please use the intercom located on the left hand side of the glass doors. On entering the building, please make your way to the Frazer-Nash reception which is located on the fourth floor.
